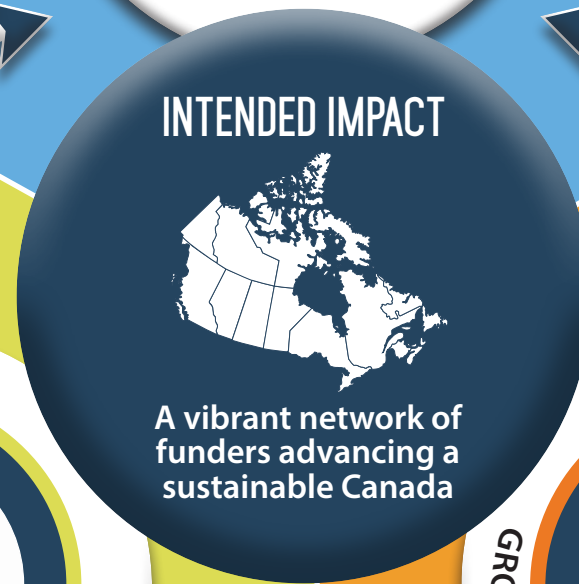


CEGN'S THEORY OF CHANGE
