The CEGN 2019 Conference Advisory Team is seeking member submissions for a session at the CEGN conference titled “**Member Snapshots: Navigating the Highs and Lows on the Impact Journey**”. This session will involve 4-5 presentations of 5 minutes each by individual CEGN Members, with a follow up discussion of 40 minutes for presenters with interested conference participants. We are looking for great ‘snapshots’ and skilled presenters who can convey the information in this very tight time frame.

The Advisory Team invites submissions, which meet a number, if not all, of the following parameters:

- Examples of funder initiatives, which fit within the conference theme of “maximizing philanthropy’s impact”. (Please review the [conference website](#) for more information on the conference theme.)
- Significant impact has been/ is being achieved
or initiative was not successful but the learning has guided future work
- Partnerships and collaboration are a major contributing factor to impact
- The initiative bridges sectors, linking environment with other societal concerns.
- Indications are that the work can be sustained
- The initiative is seen to be replicable/ scalable

- Contact information (Name; organization; email address and telephone number) for the member proposing the session.
- A brief description of the initiative addressing the parameters noted above and including the name of the proposed speaker.

Selection Process:

Members of the Conference Advisory Committee will review the submissions and will confirm the successful applicants in early April. We will then work with the successful applicant to develop the ‘snapshot’ for the conference.
